Let's Chat | Family Discussion Time

What kind things can you think of that Jesus has done for you? When we are kind to others we are acting like Jesus. Who would you like to experience God's kindness? What could you do to show them God's kindness this week?

Let's Get Creative | Craft Time

Cake in a mug.

How to make it: Microwave the butter in the mug to melt it for ten seconds, stir if needed to break it down. Add the sugars, vanilla and egg yolk and beat together well. Then add the flour mixing well to combine a consistent mixture. Fold in the chocolate chips. Microwave for a minute or so, until cooked and cookie like, keep your eye on it, this won't take long, just make sure the dough is cooked. Remove and top with extra chocolate chips if you wish to melt as it cools.
